Freitag, 9. Januar 1970: BADFINGER-LP *MAGIC CHRISTIAN MUSIC* in England.

Donnerstag, 9. Januar 1975: Oberstes Gericht von London erklärt Beziehung der BEATLES endgültig für beendet; Firma BEATLES & CO wird aus Handelsregister gestrichen; geschätzte Gesamtvermögen 225 Millionen Euro wird aufgeteilt:

je 55 Millionen Euro für JOHN LENNON und PAUL McCARTNEY,

je 30 Millionen Euro für GEORGE HARRISON und RINGO STARR.

Freitag, 9. Januar 1976: RINGO STARR-Single *OH MY MY* in England.

Dienstag, 9. Januar 1978: LONNIE DONEGAN-LP *PUTTIN ON THE STYLE* (mit RINGO STARR) in USA.

Montag, 9. Januar 1984: JOHN LENNON-Single *NOBODY TOLD ME* in USA.

Freitag, 9. Januar 2009: DAVE DEE (war bei *All You Need Is Love* in TV *OUR WORLD* dabei) in England gestorben.

Donnerstag, 29. Jan. 2009: Deutschland-Filmpremiere *ROCKER* mit PETE BEST, spielt Schlagzeuger.
