


Zwei neue BEATLES-Bücher aus den USA

DREAMING THE BEATLES is not another biography of the BEATLES, or a song-by-song analysis of the best of JOHN and PAUL. It isn't another exposé about how they broke up. This time, he focuses on the biggest pop culture phenomenon of all time - the BEATLES. In his singular voice, he explores what the BEATLES mean today, to fans who have learned to love them on their own terms and not just for the sake of nostalgia.

DREAMING THE BEATLES tells the story of how four lads from Liverpool became the world's biggest pop group, then broke up - but then somehow just kept getting bigger. At this point, their music doesn't belong to the past - it belongs to right now. This book is a celebration of that music, showing why the BEATLES remain the world's favorite thing - and how they invented the future we're all living in today.

Rob Sheffield is a contributing editor at „Rolling Stone“, where he writes about music, TV, and popular culture. He is the author of the national bestsellers „Love Is A Mix Tape“ and „Talking To Girls About Duran Duran“. He lives in Brooklyn, New York, with his wife.
